A positive HIV antibody test is scary news, but it's not a death sentence. A positive test result is an important medical message that can save or prolong your life. With proper medical care, most people are happy, healthy, and feeling well 20 years or more after becoming HIV positive



## We can help!

The Ryan White Part C program offers primary medical care, mental health counseling, nutritional education medication assistance through the ADAP program, and an overall team approach to your health care needs. Services are provided on a sliding scale fee and no one is denied services based on inability to pay. All services provided at the Okaloosa County Health Department follow state and federal confidentiality laws.

## Am I eligible?

Any person residing in Okaloosa or Walton county who is HIV positive may apply for services at the Okaloosa County Health Department. It is not necessary to have a physician referral.

## How do I enroll?

Call the Okaloosa County Health Department or OASIS at the numbers presented in this brochure to schedule an appointment for evaluation. You will meet with a case manager from OASIS for an assessment of needs. A plan of care will be implemented including a referral to Ryan White Part C EIS at the Okaloosa County Health Department.

The Ryan White Part C nurse will meet with you to complete initial paperwork, answer questions, and provide educational materials.

Arrangements will be made for you to get your initial lab work as well as an appointment to see our physician in any of our 3 clinics. Clinics are held in Crestview, Fort Walton Beach, and the Walton CHD Coastal Branch.
