Food Hygiene Permitting

All facilities licensed/inspected by the Florida Department of Health Okaloosa County must go through certain requirements to become licensed by this department:

- An appointment must be made with the environmental supervisor or Food Hygiene coordinator and a plan review completed on the proposed facility. A set of floor plans showing pertinent items such as kitchen equipment, plumbing and sanitary facilities must be provided at this time.
- **A \$40.00 plan review fee will be charged for all food facilities.**
- A sign off sheet will be given after approval of the plans. All agencies and departments must indicate final approval before the facility will be opened and/or this department will sign a beverage license.
- An application and a check for the appropriate fee must be submitted to this office before a permit/license/certificate can be issued. Upon receiving the fee and application, the receipt and permit/license/certificate will be mailed to the facility at the mailing address indicated on the application.
