Daily percent of ED visits mentioning








## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Seminole County










## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Sumter County











## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Taylor County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning









## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Union County



Daily percent of ED visits mentioning





Daily percent of ED visits mentioning






