#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Glades County



## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Hillsborough County





### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Jackson County









### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Jefferson County





## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Liberty County





## Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Volusia County





#### Emergency department (ED) and freestanding ED (FSED) chief complaint and admission data for Walton County




