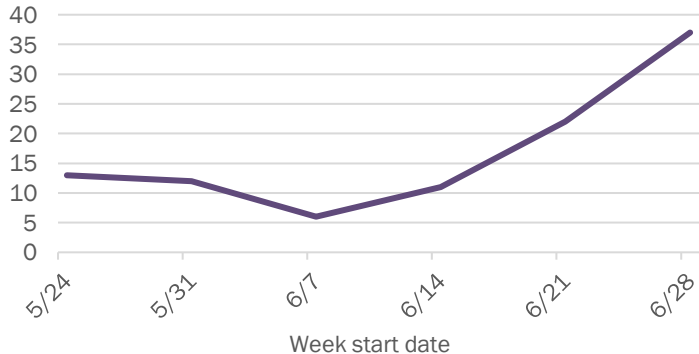
Daily percent of ED visits mentioning  
cough, fever, or shortness of breath



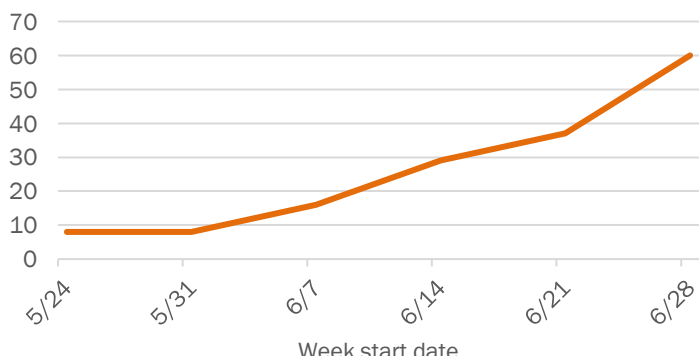
Daily percent of ED visits resulting in

COVID-like illness

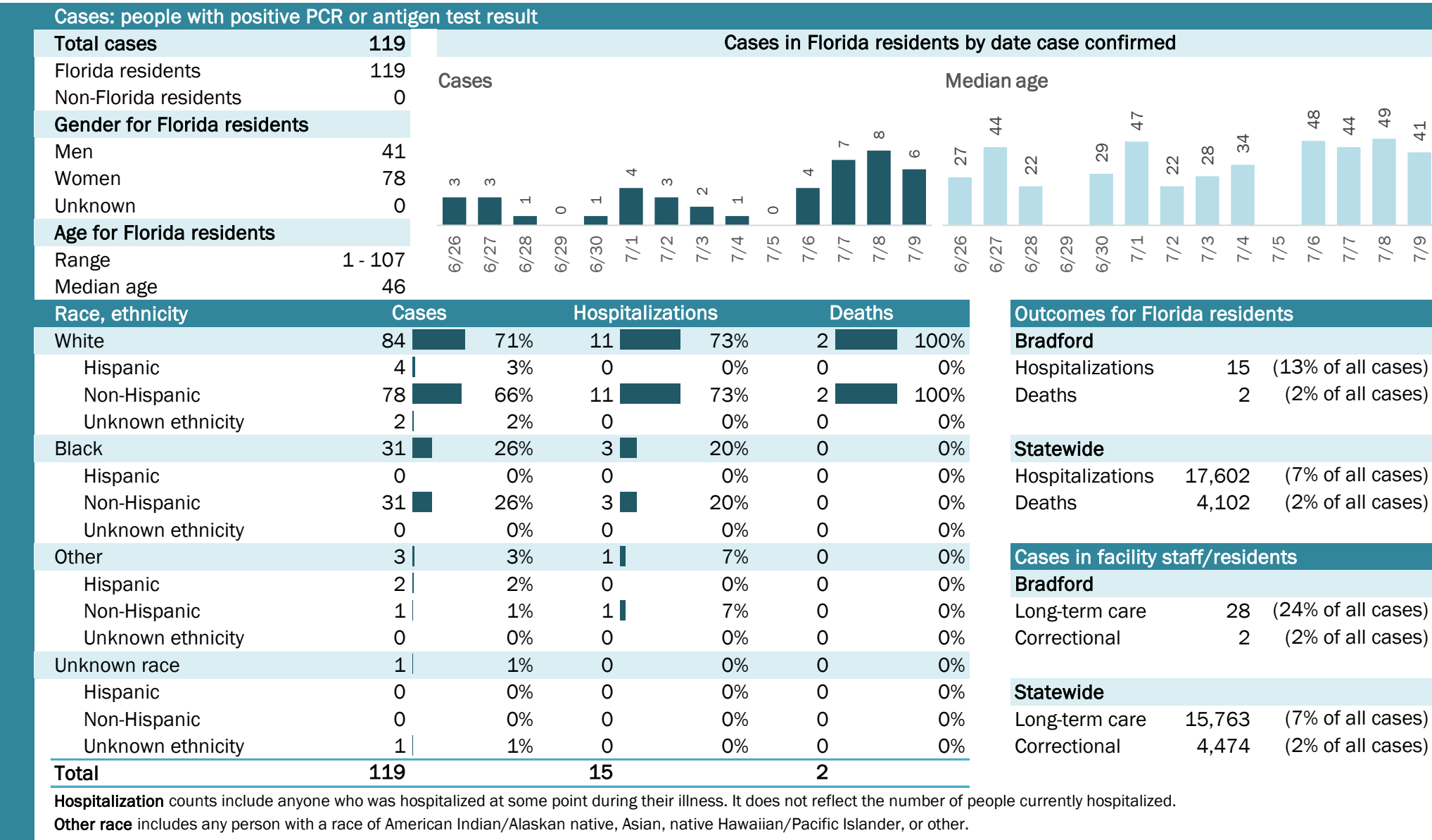
