FORT WALTON BEACH, Fla.— Florida Department of Health in Okaloosa County (DOH-Okaloosa) reminds residents to return for their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine who received first doses by DOH-Okaloosa May 11 and May 12. Everyone who received a first dose is eligible to receive the second dose.

Persons receiving their second doses will not need to register for their second appointment. Individuals should return at the same time and location of their first dose on the date provided on their COVID-19 Vaccination Record card.

Individuals will need to complete another consent form to receive their second dose. The form is available on our <u>website</u>. For those that cannot access the forms in advance, a paper copy will be provided at your appointment time.

Please return on June 1 at DOH-Okaloosa in Crestview (first vaccine received on May 11) and J Individuals should bring their COVID-19 Vaccination Record card they received after their first dose.

All individuals being vaccinated must show a valid government-issued ID at the vaccination site. This can include a passport, driver's license or military identification card.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention advises individuals to be monitored for at least 15 minutes after receiving the vaccine. Individuals will be directed to a waiting area to park and should plan accordingly.
