Food Hygiene Permitting

All facilities licensed by the Florida Department of Health in Okaloosa County must go through certain requirements to become permitted by this department:

- An appointment must be made with the Environmental Supervisor or Food Hygiene Coordinator for plan review on the proposed facility. Please submit a set of floor plans drawn to scale showing pertinent items such as kitchen equipment, plumbing and sanitary facilities at the plan review appointment. Please submit a site plan of the property.
- **For all food facilities a \$133.00 plan review fee will be charged.**
- A sign off sheet will be given after approval of the plans. All agencies and departments must indicate final approval before the facility will be opened and/or this department will sign a beverage license.
- A completed application (along with all accompanying documents) and payment for the appropriate fees must be submitted before a permit/license/certificate can be issued. Upon receiving the fee and application, the receipt and permit/license/certificate will be mailed to the facility at the mailing address indicated on the application.
