I AM A CLOSE CONTACT TO A CASE OF COVID-19 & I AM FULLY VACCINATED OR I AM WITHIN 90 DAYS OF A RECENT COVID-19 INFECTION

If you came into close contact with someone with COVID-19, you do not need to quarantine if you are in one of the following groups:

- You are ages 18 or older and have received all recommended vaccine doses, including boosters and additional primary shots for some immunocompromised people. You are considered fully vaccinated.
- You are ages 5-17 years and completed the primary series of COVID-19 vaccines. You are considered fully vaccinated.
- You had confirmed COVID-19 within the last 90 days (you tested positive using a viral test).

Close Contact: Someone who was less than 6 feet away from an infected person (laboratory-confirmed or a clinical diagnosis) for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period (for example, three individual 5-minute exposures for a total of 15 minutes)

cumulative total of 13 minutes of more over a 24-nour period (for example, timee individual 3-minute exposures for a total of 13 minutes

 □ Now get a calendar and identify 5 days from your last date of close contact (For example: last date of contact was August 1, 2021, that is Day 0. So, 5 days from contact is August 6, 2021). ■ Write down the date which is 5 days after the last contact:
□ On your calendar, identify 10 days from your last date of close contact (For example: last date of contact was August 1, 2021, that is Day 0. So, 10 days from is August 11, 2021). ■ Write down the date which is 10 days after the last contact:

☐ I am fully vaccinated, and I am well with no symptoms.
 You are exempt from staying home during quarantine.
 You should wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days from the date of your last close contact with someone with COVID-19.
 If at any time during the 10-day period you develop symptoms, get tested immediately and isolate until you receive your test results. If you test positive, follow isolation recommendations.
☐ I recovered from COVID-19 infection in the past 90 days, and I am well.
 You are exempt from staying home during quarantine.
 You should wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days from the date of your last close contact with someone with COVID-19.
